TONIGHT'S QUICK FACTS

- The Cavs and Mavericks met twice in the 2010-11 season. In those games, Antawn Jamison averaged 26.5 points and 10.5 rebounds in 39.0 minutes per game.
- Against the Magic on Feb. 3, Anderson Varejao recorded a team-high 15 rebounds (three offensive) to go along with 12 points and three steals in 34 minutes of action to record his 11th double-double of the season (53rd of career). **For the season, Varejao is averaging 11.6 rebounds per game which ranks 4th in the league, including 4.6 offensive rebounds per game which is the most in the NBA.**
- The Cavs gave up only eight fast break points to the Magic on Feb. 3 and for the season, are **giving up only 9.6 fast break points per game which is the best in the NBA. Over their last six games, the Cavs are giving up an average of 5.2 fast break points per game.**
- Kyrie Irving scored 18 points and added four rebounds and six assists in 40 minutes against the Magic on Feb. 3. **Irving is averaging 18.0 points per game, which is the most of any rookie this year. His 5.0 assists per game average is the second most among rookies.**
- Alonzo Gee scored a career-high 20 points on 7-12 (.583) shooting and added five rebounds in 31 minutes off the bench against the Magic on Feb. 3. He also shot 3-4 (.750) from three-point range. Over his last three games, Gee is averaging 15.0 points on .520 shooting, 4.7 rebounds and 2.7 steals in 29.7 minutes per game.
- **The team's television game broadcast ratings on FOX Sports Ohio have experienced a significant increase to start the current 2011-12 season and are now up approximately 50% over last season.**
- Ramon Sessions played 26 minutes off the bench and notched a game-high eight assists to go along with 14 points and six rebounds against Orlando on Feb. 3. **Sessions has had at least 10 points, five rebounds and five assists off the bench in three games this season. Over his last two games, he is averaging 10.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and 9.0 assists in 27.0 minutes.**
- Antawn Jamison recorded his first double-double of the season with 16 points and 12 rebounds in 34 minutes against Orlando on Feb. 3. **His 12 rebounds is the most he has had in a game since Feb. 25th 2011, when he grabbed 13 rebounds against the Knicks.**
- **The Cavs are currently averaging 36.3 points per game off the bench which is the second best in the Eastern Conference and is the 7th best in the league.**

KEYS TO THE GAME: Antawn Jamison recorded his eighth double-double of the season with 18 points and 11 rebounds in 39 minutes... J.J. Hickson notched his ninth double-double of the season with a game-high 26 points on 12-18 (.667), a game-high 12 rebounds and one steal in 36 minutes... Ramon Sessions finished his fourth double-double of the season with 19 points on 6-12 (.500) shooting, six rebounds, a season-high tying 13 assists and two steal in 40 minutes... Jason Terry scored 23 points and added four rebounds, five assists and two steals in 34 minutes off the bench... Shawn Marion notched a double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds in 27 minutes off the bench... Tyson Chandler recorded a double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds in 31 minutes.

Ramon Sessions finished with 19 points on 9-13 (.692) shooting, a season-high seven rebounds and a season-high 12 assists in 30 minutes... Mo Williams dished out seven assists and had two steals in 33 minutes... Shawn Marion led the Mavericks with a team-high 22 points on 11-16 (.688) shooting and five rebounds in 31 minutes... DeShawn Stevenson shot 5-12 (.417) from beyond the arc and finished with 21 points and four assists in 33 minutes... KEYS TO THE GAME: Anderson Varejao recorded his ninth double-double of the season and 51st of his career after pulling down 16 rebounds, including a season-high eight offensive, to go along with 10 points, four assists, four steals and two blocks in 37 minutes of action... Kyrie Irving scored 7 points and added a career-high tying seven assists in 30 minutes... Amar'e Stoudemire led all scorers with 19 points and had a season-high 14 rebounds to lead the team...Carmelo Anthony had a team-high six assists to go along with 15 points in 38 minutes...Tyson Chandler finished with 11 points and nine boards in 38 minutes.

TURNING POINT: After a Knicks 10-0 run in the second quarter gave New York a four point lead, the Cavs battled back to tie the game at halftime. Cleveland then outscored the Knicks by five points in both the third and fourth quarter to seal the win.

CAVS HIGHLIGHTS: Omri Casspi scored 13 points on 5-8 (.625) shooting to go along with three rebounds in 22 minutes...Anthony Parker poured in a season-high 13 points on 5-11 (.454) shooting, including 2-4 (.500) on three-pointers in 26 minutes of work..

CLEVELAND CAVALIERS TEAM NOTES

GLASS CLEANERS: This season, the Cavs own the glass on both ends of the court. **For the year, Cleveland ranks 5th in offensive rebounds per game averaging 12.3 offensive boards per contest. On the defensive end, the Cavs are giving up only 39.5 total rebounds a game which is the third fewest in the NBA.**

PERFECT VISION: Anderson Varejao scored 20 points and pulled down 20 rebounds (10 offensive) against the Boston Celtics on Jan. 31 **to become the first Cavalier to record at least 20 points and 20 rebounds in a game since Carlos Boozer** on March 30, 2004 when he had 23 points and 20 rebounds versus the Dallas Mavericks. **Varejao also became the first Cavalier to record at least 20 points and 20 rebounds with 10 offensive rebounds in a game since Kenny Carr had 27 points and 20 rebounds (11 offensive rebounds) against the New York Knicks on February 12, 1981.**

FINISH STRONG: Against the Nets on Jan. 27th, Kyrie Irving scored 21 points in the fourth quarter, including 17 in the last 2:58. **The last rookie to score at least 21 points in the fourth quarter of a game was Marcus Williams of New Jersey on November 24, 2006.** The last rookie to score at least 21 points in any quarter was Roddy Beaubois (21 in the 2nd) of the Dallas Mavericks against the Golden State Warriors on March 27, 2010. **(Elias) The last player in the NBA to score 17 or more points in the final three minutes of the game was Vince Carter who scored 18 points in the last three minutes for the Nets against Chicago on April 11, 2006. (Elias)**

DOING IT ALL: Against the Timberwolves on January 6, Anderson Varejao scored 13 points to go along with 12 rebounds (5 offensive), five assists, four steals and two blocks in 34 minutes becoming the first Cavalier to record at least those numbers since LeBron James put up 31 points, 19 rebounds, eight assists, four steals and three blocks against Charlotte on Jan. 11, 2008 and was the first person in the league to have at least those numbers since Paul Millsap against New Orleans on April 9, 2010.

REBOUND MACHINE: Anderson Varejao grabbed 10 or more rebounds in eight straight games from Jan. 4-17, which was his longest streak of consecutive games with 10-plus rebounds in his career. **The last Cavalier to pull down double-digit rebounds in at least eight consecutive games was Tyrone Hill (10 straight) from February 1, 1997 to February 23, 1997.**

BETTER ALL AROUND: In his third season in the NBA, Alonzo Gee is having his best year. **He is averaging career-highs in points (8.9), rebounds (3.9), assists (1.6) and steals (1.5). He is also shooting a career-high .500 from the field. He has recorded double-digit points in 10 of his 21 games this year (all off the bench).**

IN GOOD HANDS: In his NBA debut, Kyrie Irving scored six points while dishing out seven assists and only having one turnover against Toronto on Dec. 26. **He is the first Cav to have at least seven assists and one or fewer turnovers in their NBA debut. The last player to record seven or more assists and one or fewer turnovers in their NBA debut was Mario Chalmers who had eight assists and one turnover for Miami on 10/29/08 against the Knicks.**

YOUNG GUNS: The Cavs opening night roster has an average 3.33 years of NBA experience with is the fourth lowest average in the league and the lowest in the Eastern Conference. The Cavs have seven players with one year or less NBA experience.

PICK OF THE LITTER: In the 2011 NBA Draft, the Cavaliers selected guard Kyrie Irving with the first overall pick and forward Tristan Thompson with the fourth overall pick. Cleveland was the first team in the lottery era (since 1985) to have two picks in the top four and first team to have two of the top four picks since the Rockets in 1983.

SCHOOL IS IN SESSIONS: Ramon Sessions has proven he is one of the best backup point guards in the NBA and his numbers back it up. In 43 games off the bench in the 2010-11 season, **Sessions averaged 4.5 assists per game which was the best in the NBA.** Sessions' 12.2 points per game off the bench was the 8th best in the league among backups. He also had a 2.60:1 assist to turnover ratio when he comes off the bench which was the sixth best in the league among all backup players. (minimum 40 games)

BETTER WITH AGE: Guard Daniel Gibson and forward/center Anderson Varejao enter the 2011-12 season coming off their best statistical seasons. Last year, Gibson set career highs in points (11.6), rebounds (2.6) and assists (3.0) while playing 27.8 minutes per game. Before a season-ending injury last January, Varejao averaged career highs in points and rebounds, averaging 9.1 points and 9.7 rebounds per game in 31 games. **His 9.7 rebounds per game was the ninth most in the NBA from the start of the season to the time Varejao got injured. (31 games, ending January 5).**

NEW MAN IN TOWN: On June 30th, the Cavaliers acquired guard/forward Omri Casspi and Sacramento's first round pick (protected) in the 2012 NBA Draft from the Sacramento Kings in exchange for forward/center J.J. Hickson. Casspi, a 2009 first round NBA Draft pick, played in 71 games (27 starts) last season for the Kings, averaging 8.6 points and 4.3 rebounds in 24.1 minutes per game.

PARK-ED IN CLEVELAND: On Dec. 12, the Cavaliers re-signed guard Anthony Parker to a contract. Last season, Parker started 65 of the 72 games he played in (the second most starts on the team last season) and averaged 8.3 points, 3.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in 29.0 minutes.

NO DRAFT? NO PROBLEM: Cavs undrafted rookie Samardo Samuels quickly climbed the annals of most points scored by an undrafted rookie for the Cavaliers. Samuels finished fourth in team history with 288 points last season. Smush Parker leads the list with 408 points in the 2002-03 season.

CANTON CHARGE UPDATE: The Canton Charge, the NBA Development League team owned and operated by the Cleveland Cavaliers, currently sit at 13-15 in the D-League Eastern Conference. Guard Manny Harris leads the team in scoring averaging 18.4 points to go along with 7.4 rebounds in 12 games. Center Dante Milligan leads the team in rebounds, averaging 8.9 to go along with 9.3 points per game in 26 games.

The next show is Thursday, February 9th at 7:00 pm on the Cavs Radio Network.** Also, weekday mornings, Cavs personalities (box right) will be on News Radio WTAM 1100 with host Bill Wills and Mike Snyder to update Cavalier fans with the latest on the team and the NBA in general.

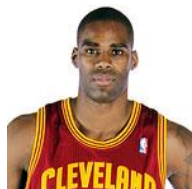
